

**LEE TOWNSHIP
Annual Meeting
Minutes**

March 31, 2007

The Annual Meeting of the Lee Township Electors was called to order at 10:14 am at the Lee Township Hall located at 877 56th Street, Pullman, MI 49450

Members Present: Trustee Christensen, Treasurer Lowery, Supervisor Schlack and Clerk King. Absent: Trustee Black.

Supervisor Schlack read the meetings from the March 25, 2006 meeting. Supervisor Schlack was requested to be the moderator of the meeting by elector Lacy.

Supervisor Schlack wanted to comment on the state of the township. He felt that the township is heading in the right direction and wanted to say that it was a privilege to accept the task and he appreciated the input from citizens.

Elector D. Allgaier-Lamberti had prepared some specific issues that she thought were important to the community. Here comments included:

- Having a survey placed at different locations in the community where citizens could input on issues that were important them.
- The clean up the community, having some type of place to look for status on the Clean up effort. A website etc. to monitor the clean up of areas sited for blight and roadside trash.
- Regular news coverage of positive events and news of the community. She felt this was good for the image of our township. Keeping with the township official website and newsletter and extending to local newspaper coverage.
- Beautication to the community. Floors etc.
- Pass an ordinance to prohibit poster being allowed on telephone/power poles.
- Setting up a microphone system to allow the boards meeting to be heard in the back of the room.
- Give the public more information on issues that are being¹ dealt with. Letters sent etc.

Supervisor comment that the township was going through a time of healing.

Elector and Chief DeWeerd commented on the condition of some of the road in the township. Could some of them be sealed and coated?

Supervisor Schlack stated that the Allegan County Road Commission was restricted by their budget and that at sometime we may be faced with a Road Millage.

It was also suggested that something be done with the township hall floor. The building contains moisture and the tiles are always chipping and lifting.

Lastly a quested was presented concerning when the repair would take place on the front awning of the hall? Supervisor Schlack stated that it would be soon.

Elector S. Lacy made a motion to close the annual meeting and the other elector's agreed. Meeting was adjourned.
