## Lee Township Special Meeting Minutes

October 5, 2010

The Special Meeting of the Lee Township Board was called to order at 6:30 pm at the Lee Township Hall, 877 56<sup>th</sup> Street, Pullman, Michigan.

Members Present: Trustee Black, Trustee Ferguson, Supervisor Miller and Clerk King. Absent: Treasurer Lowery.

The purpose of the Special Meeting was to review interested applicants for the Park Superintendent position.

Supervisor Miller passed out to the board the applicant's letters of interest for the position of Parks /Transfer Station Superintendent.

Trustee Ferguson asked why none of the applicants were in attendance. Supervisor Miller stated that he did not notify them. Interested candidates included: Jim Rawson, Paul Hapke and George Demaray. All candidates were qualified and would do a good job.

Supervisor Miller felt that Jim Rawson would be the best candidate due to the fact he had all the equipment to handle many of the transfer station's needs with snowplowing and minor work that is necessary.

Clerk King stated that all he applicants were qualified. He felt that Paul would do an excellent job, but wondered if it would interfere with the Fire Department and First Responders? He was such an asset to the community with the Fire Department and very dedicated with the First Responders.

The board discussed that Jim was currently unemployed and could devote more time to the position. The board also did not want to lose Paul as a Firefighter or First Responder due to the position. The board also noticed that George was self employed and wondered if it would be hard on him to have to arrange his hours around the weekend hours necessary for this position.

A motion was made by Miller and seconded by Black to fill the position of Parks/Transfer Station Superintendent with Jim Rawson. All voted "Aye". Motion carried.
