Reviewed minutes from February 21 meeting, highlighting areas identified to focus on for 2019.

## Improve Roads & Infrastructure

Discussion around possible efforts to refurbish old existing sidewalks in the downtown area; cost for new sidewalks; "Complete Streets" program similar to "Share the Road" with lined area for pedestrians/bikes, etc. on side of the road; the need to look at how the storm drains in town are functioning and the need to discuss with the county how raising the main roads affects run off.

## **Protect Natural Amenities (Beautification)**

Discussion on locating resource person to speak to youth (at school) on littering; option of trash pickup for all residents; increasing transfer station hours; ordinances as written and the need to review them for ways to hold violators accountable; how to fund ordinances involving property clean up. Beautification Committee already formed (Debbie Laraway, Keith Volgman, others) and raising funds to beautify four corners of downtown; possibly working with VFW for Veterans names on bricks; discussed incorporating bricks into monument that includes church bell; expanding focus to look at downtown signage, use of lighting, etc.; importance of keeping and restoring historical buildings.

<u>Promote Safety and Inclusion</u> (Connecting and information sharing with residents)

How to best disseminate information to all residents; need for translation of some information; information kiosks in designated areas.

A brief discussion on internet access also took place.

Everyone in attendance was thanked for their time, input and dedication to Lee Township and asked to invite 2 friends to the June 24 meeting who would be interested in working on moving the Master Plan goals forward.
