You should test your smoke detectors on a regular basis. Most smoke detectors have a button marked TEST, and you simply push it in. If the alarm sounds, it's fine. If it doesn't, either the detector has gone bad or the battery is worn out.

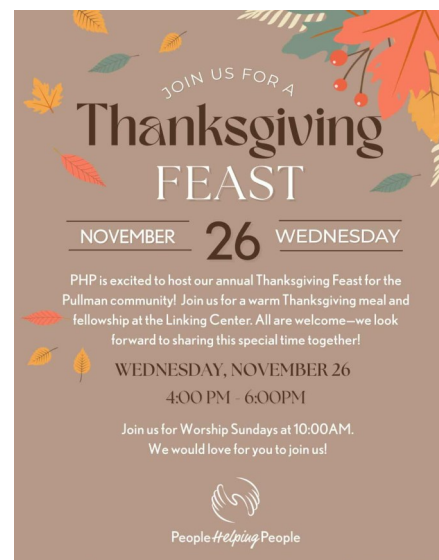

2025 WINTER TAX INFORMATION

Tax bills will be mailed by December 1st. Please check your bill upon receipt for possible errors. Errors may be corrected at the December Board of Review meeting (date and time TBD, see Township website or office).

We encourage mailing in your tax payment or putting check/money order payment in an envelope with your name and address in the drop slot at the Township office door (NOT THE ABSENTEE VOTER BOX). Receipts will be mailed if requested (write "mail receipt" on envelope). If paying by cash, the Treasurer will be in the office on Wednesday evenings to accept cash payments. No change provided, so exact payment is required. Debit and credit cards are not accepted.

The Treasurer will collect tax at the Township Office on Wednesdays (5pm-8pm) and alternate times by appointment. Interest will be added to summer taxes paid after September 15th. POSTMARKS NOT HONORED. Summer Tax 2025 must be paid to Lee Twp. Treasurer until March 2, 2026. Beginning March 3, 2026, all unpaid taxes (Summer & Winter) become delinquent and must be paid to the ALLEGAN COUNTY TREASURER, with an additional 4% penalty and 1% interest per month. Verify the correct amount to be paid by contacting the County Treasurer's Office at 673-0260 or www.allegancounty.org.

Defer penalty and interest

Qualifying senior citizens or permanently disabled persons may defer penalty and interest on tax payments until April 30th for Homeowner's Principal Residence only. Notify the Township Treasurer to apply for a Deferment Application at the receipt of your tax bill. Winter deferments must be submitted by Feb. 16th. Summer deferments were due by September 15th. For Disabled Veterans Exemption call the Township office or get the form from our website @ www.leetwp.org.

A Note from Heather Jahr, Lee Township Assessor

Please be aware of the following:

⇒ Any time a deed or land contract is drafted the Grantee (person or entity acquiring the property) needs to file a Property Transfer Affidavit with the Township Assessor. This document serves as notification of a change in ownership and is paired with the deed recorded at the Allegan County Register of Deeds.

⇒ If you have recently purchased property in Lee Township that is your principal residence, you must file a completed Principal Residence Exemption Affidavit with Lee Township in order to claim the exemption. Forms can be found on the Township website leetwp.org.

⇒

Property owners are encouraged to review their parcel record card. Verification of record card details assures that the physical attributes present on the parcel are properly reflected on the Assessment and Tax Rolls.

Property owners are highly encouraged to ensure that Lee Township has the correct mailing address on file for all property owners. Changes made to mailing addresses at the post office will not cause a change of mailing address on the Township records.

Property owners are reminded that the annual Notice of Assessment is mailed in mid-February. This document includes the changes to Assessed and Taxable Value for the current year and instructions on how to carry out an appeal of valuation at the March Board of Review, if desired.
