PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a General Election will be held in said Township/City on Tuesday, November 4, 2008. The last day for receiving registrations for the General Election will be Monday, October 6, 2008. Persons residing in the Township/City registering after 5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 6, 2008 will not be eligible to vote at the General Election. Persons planning to register must determine when the office of the City, Township or County Clerk or the Secretary of State Branch office will be open for registration in person. Registration may also be made at the specified agency for clients receiving services through the Department of Human Services, The Department of Community Health, Michigan Jobs Commission and some offices of the Commission for the Blind and at the military recruitment offices for persons enlisting in the armed forces. Registration by mail may be used by obtaining and completing a Mail Voter Registration Application and forwarding to the election official as directed on the application by the close of registration deadline. A person who registers to vote by mail is required to vote in person unless they have previously voted in person in the City/Township where they live or are at least 60 years of age or are handicapped, or have satisfied ID requirements with the local clerk. Only persons who have registered as General electors with the appropriate City, Township or County Clerk or through registration at a Secretary of State Branch office or at any specified agency or military recruitment office or by using an official mail registration application, are registered electors of their jurisdiction.

PERSONS ENTITLED to be registered voters in said County must possess the following qualifications on or before the day of the General Election: (1) a citizen of the United States; (2) not less than 18 years of age; (3) a resident of the State of Michigan and the local municipality for not less than 30 days prior to the General Election (MCL 168.492). In addition, qualified electors must be registered to vote not less than 30 days prior to the General Election (MCL 168.497).

MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be imposed on taxable property in Lee Township, Allegan County, be increased by One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) per thousand dollars (1.50 mills) of the taxable value for a period of five (5) years, 2008 to 2012, inclusive, as a renewal of that portion of a 1.50 mills authorization previously authorized by the electors as reduced by operation of the Headlee amendment, which was 1.3260 mills in 2007, plus new additional millage in the amount equal to the amount reduced by operation of the Headlee amendment which was 0.1740 mill, to provide funds to Lee Township for emergency medical first responder services? It is estimated that 1.50 mills would raise approximately \$87,200 when first levied in 2008
